




Romanae ecclesiae fidelis filia, multorum millium sanctorum ditissimam^{um} nau-
-thecium, ceteras inter prerogativas, quas sibi vindicat, non minima est, quod
virum genuerit, qui religioni, scientiae et sanctitate famosus ordinem celebra-

Quos ut placarent primarii patres, durissimas conditiones cum eisdem compulsi fuerunt mittere, ut in sequentibus patebit.

Tactis igitur fundamentis, et potente virtute divina plures ad hoc pium opus perficiendum stimulate acciti quoque Moguntia sunt patres anno 1335, circa initium Februarii, qui locum deputatum initiarent, et ad formam ordinis redigerent, quorum primarius V. P. D. Joannes de Epternaco, cognomento Polonus domus sancti Joannis Baptistæ in Seix professor, qui primos Cartusianos intra urbem Ubiorum dux præclarus introduxit, ac designatis sedibus collocavit.

Vir non minus pietate in Deum, quam prudentia in rebus gerendis excellens, ut prote, qui tantam, tamque laboriosam difficultemque provinciam circa augmentationem domus sustinuerit, ut sive prospera sive adversa spectes, que ipso clarum tenente multa et varia acciderunt, electum a Deo ^{esse} credas ~~esse~~, ut per dubias ac turbulentas tempestates, ipso duce navem pusillam hujus domus ad portum salutis dirigeret.

Ceterum qualiter et quamdiu profuerit nullibi reperitur, nisi quod ante obitum ex hac vita qui fuit 14. Novembris anno 1370 fuit absolutus prioratus.

Ne celeberrimi hujus viri acta cursim transeamus, placeat illius vitam altius discutere. Natus Calcaria in ducatu Clevenensi anno Dni 1328. Puer cum esset humanioribus literis imbutus est in patria ^{adulescens?} celosens Colonice gravioribus disciplinis perpolitus, exinde in Galliam secedens, Lutetia Parisiorum sacram theologiae egregie dedit, et magisterii lauream accepit, indeque reversus, optimis ecclesiarum collegiarum Sancti Georgii Colonice et Sancti Ivotherti in Casuaris insula prebendis ditatus fuit: quibus aliquandiu perfruitus, animadvertens lubricum in ipsis statum, res suas seculum habere iussit, et omnia ejus ornamenta tanquam sterces arbitratus nudus ad Christi nudi crucifixum confregit, et rix jam matura aetate, annos natus 37 sacrum Coetusiensium habitum suscepit Colonice anno 1365, in quo brevi tempore ad eos profecit, ut tertio post anno videlicet 1368 in domo monachorum prope Anthenium in Priorem assumptus fuerit ubi annis quinque laudabiliter expletis cum circa annum Dni 1373. Nova cepisset fundari Cartusia Brevenunda in Geldria, ipse ad hoc opus assumptus fuit ut Rector, primus prima illius jaceret fundamenta, quo in munere, atque in excolendo illo nudi agro preclare se gessit.

At quinquennium vix illic existens, cum domus suae professionis perbitum Dni Joannis de Breida esset privatior pastore, propriae suae cogitur praesse, Prior domui, anno 1377 in Tunis. Nec indecim destitit sollicitus esse pro sua novella plantatione quoad anno sequenti a Capitulo generali eidem mandaretur huic providere de alio Rectore.

Porro hic Prior, tametsi domum suam pauperulam inveneris, in eadem multa bona et laude digna fecit maximam quoque calamitatem expertus tempore schismatis anno 1378. It notes that time constraints and limited resources can often hinder the ability to gather all necessary data. However, by using efficient methods and prioritizing key areas, it is possible to overcome these obstacles.

Finally, the document concludes with a summary of the findings and recommendations. It suggests that regular audits and updates to the data collection process are essential for maintaining the accuracy and relevance of the information. The author also encourages ongoing communication and collaboration among team members to ensure that everyone is working towards the same goals.
